

## **Oregon Lifeline Program**

Programs for Low Income Subscribers Residents in the SCTC/PTC/SCS serving area whose income is at or below the current federal poverty level may be eligible for state sponsored programs that provide them with a reduction in their monthly telephone and qualifying broadband service bills. Through the Oregon Telephone Assistance Program (OTAP), qualifying customers receive service at a reduced rate each month. This program is funded through the legislatively approved telecommunications service surcharge and the waived portion of the FCC subscriber line charge. The Oregon Public Utility Commission (PUC) manages the Oregon Lifeline program. If you qualify, this federal and state government assistance program reduces your monthly landline, wireless or broadband bill up to \$12.75.
